A walk in Bombon

Information on the walk

Parking: Place de l'église, on the left side.

The walks, step by step...

- 1** The start of the village walk is at the **church of Saint-Germain**. Walk along the side of the church to admire the building from the front.
- 2** Leave Place de l'Église via the Grande Rue towards the Town Hall.
- 3** By following the Grande Rue, you will see on your left the **farmhouse of Neuvy**.
- 4** Continue a little along the Grande Rue and turn left onto the Rue Grange des Rognères. The **well** is located at the intersection of these two streets.
- 5** Continue along the Rue Grange des Rognères and turn right onto the narrow path of Gerbette. This trail winds through private gardens and fields. You then cross the Rue du Bourg and the Rue de Bréau. Continue on the path to the end. At the end, turn right and, after a few meters, take a left into the Rue du château.
- 6** At the end of the Rue du château, you will arrive at the northern entrance of the **château** (private site). An information panel is located near the eastern facade. To find the château, take the Rue du Parc on the right, then arriving in the Rue de Forest, make a detour to the left until you arrive at the main gate of the château.
- 7** Go back to the village via the Rue de Forest and turn left into the Rue des Charnois. You will pass near the old wash house and take a right onto the grassy path. Then walk along the field to the village.
- 8** You will then be facing the imposing **farmhouse of Forest**, an information panel is located next to its entrance. To see it, continue along the Rue de Forest. Then retrace your steps to go around the building by the Forest path.
- 9** Follow the Forest path to the Grande Rue which will take you back to the church of Saint-Germain.
